God DISCIPLINES His people (Deut. 4:36, Job 5:17, Psalms 39:11, Jer. 46:28)

BLESSED are those who receive God's discipline (Psalm 94:12, Proverbs 1:7)

We should never REJECT God's discipline (Proverbs 3:11, 10:17, 12:1, 13:18)

God disciplines those He LOVES (Hebrews 12:7-8, Revelations 3:19)

Discipline is not PLEASANT but will bring the best in us (Hebrews 12:11)

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

Matthew 18:15-17 - If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over. But if he will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, treat him as you would a pagan or a tax collector.

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

The **OFFENDED** believer if responsible to arrange a private meeting and confront the erring brother/sister (Galatians 6:1)

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

Private REPROOF- show him his fault between the two of you

Private CONFERENCE- take one or two others along

Public ANNOUNCEMENT- tell it to the church

Public EXCLUSION- treat him as you would a pagan or a tax collector

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

God has **MORAL STANDARDS** that Christians should follow

In every step of discipline process, **REPENTANCE** must be required

The Church cannot be **SOFT** on "SIN" and condone its destructive effects

Corrective discipline must be motivated by **LOVE** and **GRACE** of God

CARE-frontation

James 5:16 - Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be **HEALED**. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

MODES OF ACCOUNTABILITY (Cecy 2011)

CONSISTENT Accountability (*Knowing I will be tempted, I need to meet with someone regularly*)

DEFENSIVE Accountability (*Before I am tempted, I need to share my particular struggles with someone*)

OFFENSIVE Accountability (*I am being tempted right now. I need help*)

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

A.C.T.S. of REPENTANCE

Admitting my Sin – Refusing to Hide, Stop Blaming Others, Grieving Over my Sin

Confessing My Sin – From your mouth to God's ears

Turning from My Sin – decision to leave the sinful lifestyle

Strengthening Other Sinners (ref. Psalm 51:12-13)

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

A.C.T.S. of REPENTANCE

Psalms 51:12,13 - Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will turn back to you.

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM

WHO TO INVITE?

- ✓ Same sex group
- ✓ Do not gossip
- ✓ Limit to 6 to 7 people (10 minutes per person)
- ✓ The leader is a facilitator
