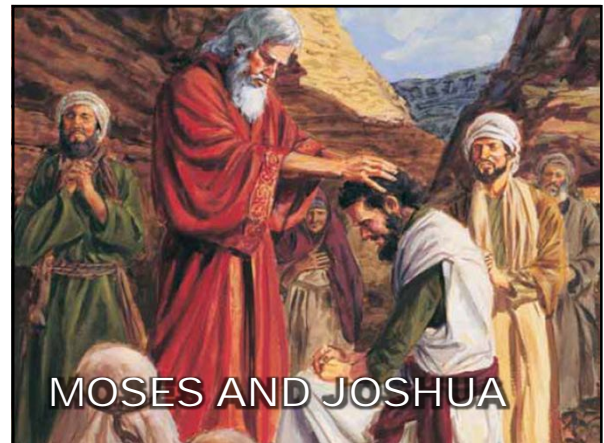


Acts 5:38-39

Joshua son of Nun, the servant of the LORD, died at the age of a hundred and ten. And they buried him in the land of his


FAIL!

you have FAILED!**



 But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

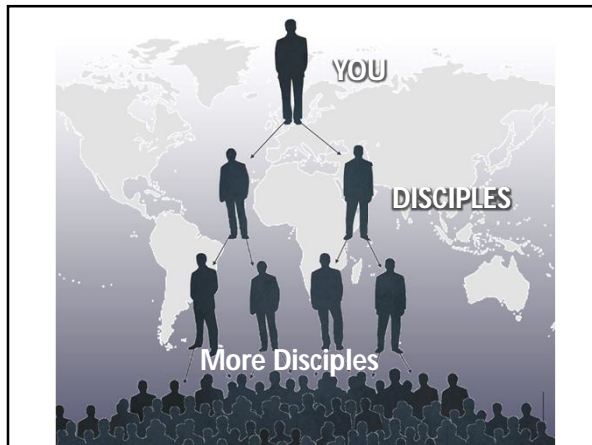
THE WAY OF JESUS
(Coleman 1965)

- Incarnation: Jesus became a servant*
- Selection: Concentrate on a few
- Association: He stayed with them
- Consecration: He required obedience
- Impartation: He gave himself
- Demonstration: He showed them how to live
- Delegation: He assigned them work
- Supervision: He kept check on them
- Reproduction: He expected them to reproduce

Leadership Principles

There must be a **DIMINISHING** dependency on the leader

2 Timothy 2:2
 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others.



YOU HAVE HEARD ME SAY...

You must have a discipler/mentor

You must be **WILLING** to be disciplined

Mentoring types: Spiritual parents, conferences, seminars, books

ENTRUST TO RELIABLE MEN...

FAITHFUL – Pure Heart, Servanthood

AVAILABLE – No Excuses

TEACHABLE – Willing to Learn

TO TEACH OTHERS...

The teaching/training cycle should never stop.
