





Ephesians 1:13-14



Fact: Sheep are afraid of running waters


The Lord is our peace and rest (Yahweh-SHALOM)

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.




Shoob- restore, "to go back" or "retreat" to the Lord


Fact: Sheep are DUMB!

Fact: The Sheep's way up to the higher ground, which has plenty of water and grass, is called Valley of Death due to rock mudslides, predators, and poisonous plants

Drawing sheep together, guiding them and rescuing those who are in danger


Hebrews 12:7-11




Cleanse *your* hands, sinners; and purify your hearts, double-minded ones.




Fact: This refers to tablelands on which the sheep have been journeying. Metaphorically, table means "banquet" or "feast"














Deuteronomy 28:2, 15
