But when you look up to heaven, you'll see God smiling upon you.









Luke 23:34 (NASB)

In the original Greek, the word "saying" means that it is repeated several times. Jesus repeated his appeal.




Why Appeal? 2. Practice what he preached. Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times?" Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times. (Matthew 18:21-22) Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. (Luke 6:37)







This does not literally mean that they do not know what they are doing.


What does this people do not know?

3. They do not know the gravity of their sins.





















- 1. Recognize that you are hurt.
