

PUT ON JESUS!

Our fallen, sinful nature makes flesh (sarx) strong

To defeat your sinful flesh, your must surrender to CHRIST!



- 1. The average adult human brain weighs three pounds, has a texture like firm jelly and is made up of 75 percent water.
- Every time your heart beats, your arteries carry 20 to 25 percent of your blood to the brain. The harder you think, the more oxygen and fuel your brain will use from your blood – up to 50 percent.
- 3. Every time you recall a memory or have a new thought, you create a connection in the brain.

- 4. There are 100 billion neurons (nerve cells) in the brain, but they make up only 10 percent of the brain. These neurons branch out to 100 trillion-plus trigger points, forming what experts call a "neuron forest."
- 5. Size doesn't matter in the brain. There is no evidence that a larger brain is smarter than a smaller brain.
- 6. There are 100,000 miles of blood vessels in the brain. The distance around the world at the equator is 24,900 miles.
- 7. It is normal for your mind to wander. There are parts of the brain that control "task-unrelated thought" (such as daydreaming).
- 8. Adults who participated in mind-challenging activities were 63 percent less likely to develop dementia (i.e Alzheimer's disease).

- 9. The average number of thoughts a person has each day is 70,000.
- 10. The rate at which your brain processes information can range from 0.5 meters/second (about 1 mile per hour) to 120 meters/second (268 MPH).





Proverbs 23:7 (NKJV) - "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he..."

A = External Event (good/bad)

B = Belief/thinking about A

C = How you feel about A

A = Mother notices Internet use

B = She is being unreasonable

C = You hate your mom

To change C (feeling), you must change B (thinking) - reframing

Sinful nature results in Sinful Mind Romans 8:5-8- Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those controlled by the sinful nature cannot please God.

1 Corinthians 2:14 - The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Philippians 3:19 - Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is on earthly things.

Main strategy of the enemy: DECEPTION

2 Corinthians 11:3 - But I am afraid that just as Eve was deceived by the serpent's cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere and pure devotion to Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:3-4- But also if our gospel is hidden, it is hidden to those being lost, in whom the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving ones, so that the light of the glorious gospel of Christ (who is the image of God) should not dawn on them.

We must GUARD our Minds! 1 Peter 5:8- Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6- For though walking about in flesh, we do not war according to flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not fleshly, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds, pulling down imaginations and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought into the obedience of Christ; and having readiness to avenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

Philippians 4:8 - Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.

Philippians 4:6,7 - Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:1,2- Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Our minds should be SUBJECTED to the Lordship of Christ!
